Detailed Itinerary:



Day 1: Arrive in Moshi – 6,004 Feet.

Arrive in Moshi with Representatives and transferred to your hotel for overnight stay.



Day 2: Machame Camp – 10,000 Feet.

After breakfast, you will begin your drive to Kilimanjaro National Park. It is approximately 1.5 hours drive from your hotel to the Machame Gate. You will have to register with the park staff. Your representative will take care of the paper work for you, including porters; once this is done, you will start trekking through the superb rainforest to Machame Camp where you will stay overnight and dinner will be served. The hike from the gate to your first stop (Machame Hut) is about 5 hours. This is overall a pretty smooth patch with some steep part, so take it easy on this first day and make sure you have all your gears on!



Day 3: Shira Camp – 12,500 Feet.

Ascend to Shira Hut. A short descent from Machame Hut followed by an hour or so of hard uphill to the top of the forest, then 2 hours at a more gentle angle through the lower moorlands brings one to the top of a rocky bluff. Lunch is normally taken here. From here, descend 50 ft then start traversing westwards, up towards Shira Cathedral. The last sections of this route is relatively flat and easy - but once again, take it very slowly. You spend a night at Shira Camp and dinner will be served.

Day 4: Barranco Camp – 13,000 Feet.

Ascending to Kibo, passing valley and climbing the ridge crest, while crossing scree slopes and a river valley to reach Barranco camp. Stay overnight at Barranco Camp where dinner will be served.



Day 5: Barafu Hut – 15,500 Feet.

Trekking across the floor of the Great Barranco Valley to the Barranco Wall to Karanga river. This is the last water point. Stay overnight at the campsite and dinner will be served.

Day 6: Mweka Camp – 19,340 Feet

You will have an early start for your final ascend. Put on all your clothing ready for the final ascent. You will be climbing up scree for approximately 4-5 hours. The views from the mountain (on the way up) are spectacular - you gain incredible height over a short distance. You arrive at Stella Point (18,860 feet), just at the top of the crater, have a rest - the sun should be shining! From here continue on a relatively easy path up to Uhuru peak , the highest point in Africa. Descend via Barafu camp trekking through the forest to Mweka Camp. Stay overnight at Mweka camp.



Day 7: Final Descend

Descend through the forest to the park gate at Mweka College. Taken to Hotel in Moshi for overnight stay and dinner.

Day 8 – Departure

After breakfast, to be picked up by representative and to the airport for your final departure.
