## Detailed Itinerary:



### Day 1: Arrive in Moshi – 6,004 Feet.

Arrive in Moshi with Representatives and transferred to your hotel for overnight stay.



### Day 2: Mandara Hut – 8,856 Feet.

After breakfast, you will begin your drive to Kilimanjaro National Park. It is approximately 2 hours drive from your hotel to the Marangu Gate. You will have to register with the park staff. Your representative will take care of the paper work for you, including porters; once this is done, you will start trekking through the superb rainforest to Mandara Hut where you will stay overnight and dinner will be served.



### Day 3: Horombo Hut – 12,136 Feet.

Trek through the moorland to reach Horombo which will take approximately 5 hours. You will be provided with packed lunch and dinner will be served at Horombo. Stay overnight at Horombo encampment. It is strongly advised to take minimum of at least 2ltr water per day, especially as you ascend higher towards the peak. Take enough fluids – tea, soups, water to keep you hydrated.

### Day 4: Kibo Hut – 15,416 Feet.

Ascending to the saddle of Kilimanjaro, between the peaks of Kibo and Mawenzi. Passing the last water point. Stay overnight at the Kibo encampment. Dinner will be served.



### Day 5: Uhuru Peak – 18,640 Feet.

You will have an early morning climb to the summit of Kilimanjaro. Ascend upon steep and heavy scree reaching Gilman's point on the crater rim of the mountain located at 18,640ft / 5861m, then onto Uhuru Peak, the highest point in Africa -5895m. After Uhuru Peak you will return to Horombo encampment for the evening. You spend the night at Horombo where dinner will be served.

### Day 6: Moshi

After breakfast, descend the mountain to the park gate. Dinner and overnight stay at hotel in Moshi.

### Day 7: Departure

To be picked up by representatives from your hotel and transferred to the airport for your final departure.
