Detailed Itinerary:



Day 1: Arrival at Cairo International Airport

Arrival to Cairo, meet & assist through formalities at Cairo international Airport by our representative, transfer to the hotel, Check in, evening at leisure & overnight.

Day 2: Pyramid Tours and Guided Shopping Tour

Breakfast, then start full day tour visiting the great Pyramids of Giza area. The three Pyramids: Cheops, Chephren and Mycrenos, which are guarded by the mysterious Sphinx with the body of a lion and a human head. The Great Pyramids is one of the Seven Wonders of the World and the most important tourist site in Egypt. Then you will continue to visit the Egyptian Museum, the Museum houses about 250.000 antique pieces covering the whole history of ancient Egypt, which extends over the past five thousand years. After that you will be guided to a shopping tour. Egypt is known for its world class handicrafts, jewelry, perfumes. Visiting the bazaars is a great opportunity where tourists can pick excellent gifts of Egyptian perfume when you are visiting the perfume factory, also you can buy Papyrus and enjoy an explanation of how ancient Egyptian manufactured it and how it lasted over than 100 years, cotton wear, gold, silver jewelry & souvenirs are also available. Transfer to the station to take the sleeping train to Luxor. Dinner and overnight on board.



Day 3: Luxor Tours (Every Saturday or Monday)

Breakfast in the train then arrival to Luxor and start the sightseeing tours as follows:

A.M - Embarkation before Lunch.

P.M - Visit Karnak and Luxor Temples & Overnight in Luxor

The visits of West Bank includes the Colossi of Memnon, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El-Bahari and the Valley of Kings, Luxor Temple & Karnak Temple.



Day 4: West Bank Tours

Morning: Cross to West Bank. Visit the Valley of Kings, the Temple of queen Hatshepsut at El- Deir El-Bahari and Colossi of Memnon.

The Temple of Deir El-Bahri is one of the most characteristic temples in the whole of Egypt, due to its design and decorations. It was built of limestone, not sandstone like most of the other funerary temples of the New Kingdom period.

Perhaps the most imposing monument on the West Bank at Luxor are the famous 'Colossi of Memnon'. These massive quartzite (or quartzose sandstone) statues which once flanked the entrance to Amenhotep III's mortuary temple now stand virtually alone in a field at the side of the road to the valley of the kings.



Afternoon: Sail to Esna & Cross the Lock. Sail to Edfu & Overnight.

The Temple of Khnum at Esna was built in Greco-Roman times by the Ptolemies. Cleopatra was the last of the Ptolemy Pharaohs. The remains of the Temple of Esna sit in a deep hole that represents the 2000 year accumulation of debris from the local town.





Day 5: Temple of Horus and Kom Ombo in Edfu

During the day, you will visit the Temple of Horus; one of the most complete architectures in Egypt dedicated for God Horus and son Osiris.

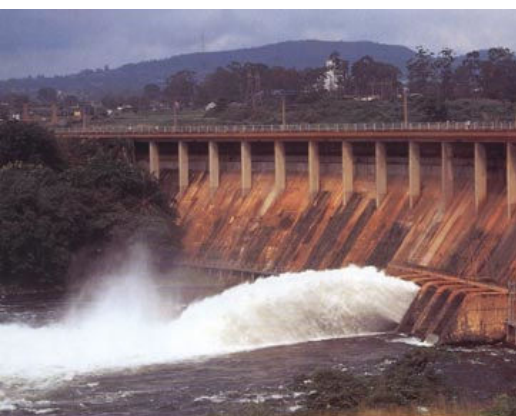
The Temple of Horus in Edfu (also known as the Temple of Edfu) is considered the best-preserved cult temple in Egypt. This partly because it was built later than most: in the Ptolemaic era from 237 to 57 BC.

In the afternoon, you will Sail to Kom Ombo and Visit the Temple shared by the two Gods Sobek and Haroeris; with an overnight in Aswan.



The Temple of Kom Ombo stands on the east bank of the Nile, right next to the river, about 4Km from the town. The Temple was mainly dedicated to the God Sobek, the crocodile God, together with his wife, in another form of the Goddess Hathor. The Temple is of Greco-Roman structure, dating back to the year 119 BC, when Ptolemy VI, who started the construction, built it out of limestone. Neos Dionysus finished most of the building, while the Emperor Augustus added the final touches.

Day 6: Elephantine Island and Botanical Gardens



In the morning after breakfast, you will proceed to visit the High Dam passing by the Old Dam of Aswan. nomy of Egypt. For the first time in history, the annual Nile flood can be controlled by man. The dam impounds the floodwaters, releasing them when needed to maximize their utility on irrigated land, to water hundreds of thousands of new acres, to improve navigation both above and below Aswan.

In the afternoon, you will continue your tour to visit the Elephantine Island, The Botanical Gardens and the Aga Khan Mausoleum by Felucca. Elephantine [Island](#) is the largest island in the area. On the island you find many sightes going back to Pharaonic times.

Day 7: Depart for Cairo



Disembarkation after Breakfast. Free at leisure **"own arrangements"**, and then transfer to the station to take the sleeping train back to Cairo.

Dinner & overnight on board.

Day 8: Final Departure

Breakfast onboard and arrive Cairo and day at leisure. You will then be transferred to your hotel or airport for your final departure
