The Rongai Route approaches Kilimanjaro from the north and retains a sense of untouched wilderness lost on the crowded Marangu and Machame trails. The easiest of all the routes, it has a relatively gentle gradient and short daily stages as it winds its way from the starting point just south of the Kenya-Tanzania border. The final ascent is arduous and made in darkness, but the reward is a spectacular dawn view of the glaciers and ice cliffs of the summit, and across the East African plains far below. Descending through lush forest, there is time to relax and recover before the flight home

Detailed Itinerary:



Day 1: Arrive in Moshi – 6,004 Feet.

Arrive in Moshi with Representatives and transferred to your hotel for overnight stay.



Day 2: Simba Camp

After breakfast, short drive to Kilimanjaro National Park. Register with the park staff and thereafter proceed to Rongai Gate - 1900 m (3 hour drive). After clearance at the gate you trek through a dense forest with giant ferns, moss and creepers hanging off the trees, reaching Simba Camp. Dinner and overnight stay at Simba Camp. Trekking time around 4 hours.

Day 3: Second Cave Camp

After breakfast in the morning you walk through moorland to a second cave camp - 3700 m. Dinner and overnight stay at this cave camp. Trekking time around 4 hours.



Day 4: Third Cave Camp

After breakfast, we continue our ascent to reach the third cave camp. Trek time is about 4 hours and the route becomes much steeper than before as you increase your altitude. Your lunch will be served during the hike and you will end the day with an overnight at this cave camp and dinner will be served.

Day 5: Tent

breakfast walk to Kibo hut - 4700 m. At the hut we join groups ascending through the Marangu route. You will continue to sleep in your tents while those from Marangu will sleep in huts. Dinner and overnight stay at Kibo Hut. Trek time is about 4 hrs.



Day 6: Horombo Hut

After a good night rest, you will start your final ascend in the darkness of Kilimanjaro at 1:30am. This is by far the most challenging part of the climb which will take you approximately 6 hours to complete. But at the end, it will be all worth it when you reach Gillman's Point to rest and watch the sunrise over Mawenzi. You will continue trekking and reach your final destination – Uhuru Peak – the highest point in Africa and prepare for the descend back and spend a night at the Horombo Hut; where dinner will be served.

Day 7: Final Descend

After breakfast, descend to Mandara hut where you will have a short rest then proceed to Marangu gate - 1800 m. At the gate you will be awarded your certificates, if successful. You will then return to your hotel in Moshi for dinner and stay overnight.



Day 8 – Departure

After breakfast, to be picked up by representative and to the airport for your final departure.
