Detailed Itinerary:

Day 1: Tarangire National Park

Depart from Arusha to Tarangire for lunch, Afternoon game drive.

Herds of up to 300 elephants scratch the dry river bed for underground streams, while migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland crowd the shrinking lagoons. It's the greatest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem - a smorgasbord for predators – and the one place in Tanzania where dry-country antelope such as the stately fringe-eared oryx and peculiar long-necked gerenuk are regularly observed.



On drier ground you find the Kori bustard, the heaviest flying bird; the stocking-thighed ostrich, the world's largest bird; and small parties of ground hornbills blustering like turkeys.

More ardent bird-lovers might keep an eye open for screeching flocks of the dazzlingly colourful yellow-collared lovebird, and the somewhat drabber rufous-tailed weaver and ashy starling – all endemic to the dry savannah of north-central Tanzania.

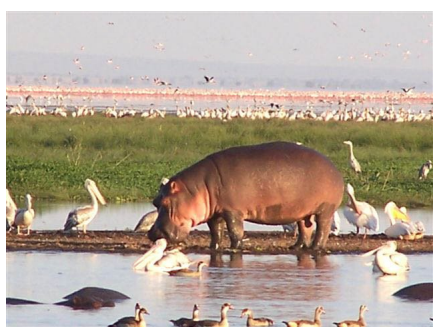


After game drive, you will then drive to Manyara National Park for dinner and overnight at Kirumuru Tented Camp or Manyara Serena Lodge.

Day 2: Morning Drive – Manyara National Park

After breakfast, you will take a drive into the Manyara National Park.

This park (123 sq mi/319 sq km) is in the Great Rift Valley which is famous for its tree-climbing lions (they go up in the acacia trees during the heat of the day) and thousands of pink flamingos. Thanks to the varied terrain (woodland, lakes, open grassland and groundwater forests of breadfruit and fig trees), there's a wide variety of animal life, including some 350 different species of birds. It's worth at least an overnight. Not far from the park is **Mto Wa Mbu** (pronounced *OOM-tow-wa-OOM-boo*), a village that's now home to people from many different tribes. Irrigation has turned it into an oasis; it used to be just grazing land for the cattle of the nomadic Masai people. Try some of the local banana beer.
